Elementary and Middle School Student Possessions

Elementary final opportunity to pick up your students' content of their desk and/or locker will be on Wednesday, May 20th from 4:00pm-5:30pm.

Middle School final opportunity to pick up your students' content of their desk and/or locker will be on Wednesday, May 20th from 10:30am-noon.

- Academic lockers were cleaned out and sorted by school personnel.
- WCSD property and trash were removed.
 - Students' personal items were bagged and labeled according to locker #
- Remember, not all students left personal items in their lockers. All books, school property, computers, and trash have been removed. Ask your child if they have any personal items before coming to school.
- All items not picked up by May22nd will be donated.

For middle school students: drive to the front of the middle school building and follow the signs.
For elementary school students: drive to the east side of the elementary school building (the bus drop off area)

Please hold up a paper with the locker number and/or students' names on it so that it is large enough, bold enough and visible to the school employees. A person will radio inside and they will get your bag of items. To stay consistent with CDC guidelines we ask that you drive thru and stay in your car. Once we have your items we will place them in your trunk and you can drive away. There will be an area in the west parking lot where all of the lost and found items are located, if you are missing anything you may look through those clothing items. Whatever is not claimed by May 22 will be donated to Goodwill. Thank you for being patient with us and this process.
