

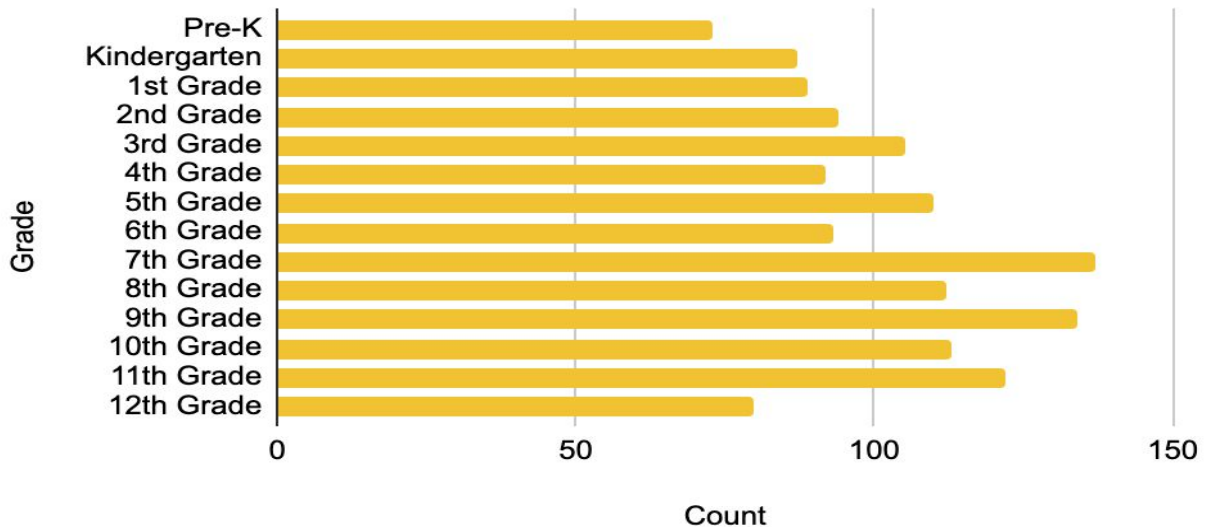


Winterset CSD - Parent Return to Learn - Summary

The following graphs and information represent a summary of the information that was provided by 867 parents/guardians who completed the survey. The survey was sent to 1783 parents/guardians for a completion rate of **48.6%**. The survey was sent to 906 households, so depending on whether or not each parent filled out the survey or if they completed it as a household, the completion rate could be higher. 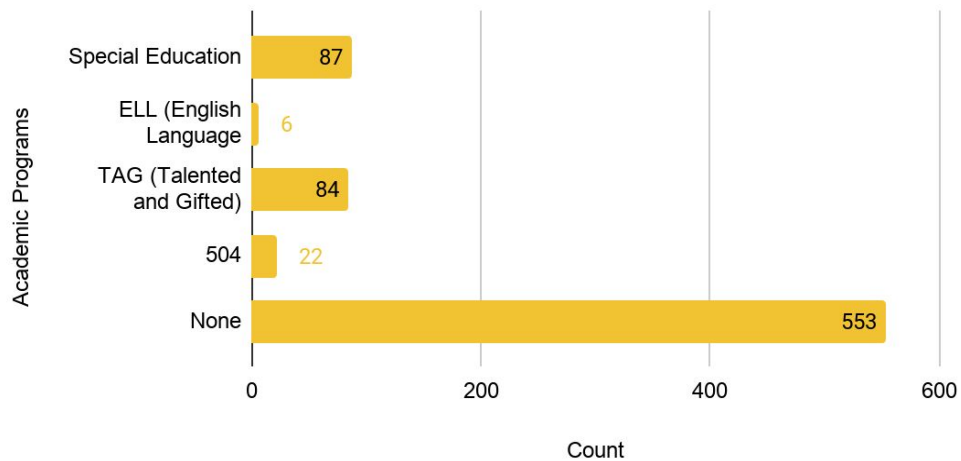




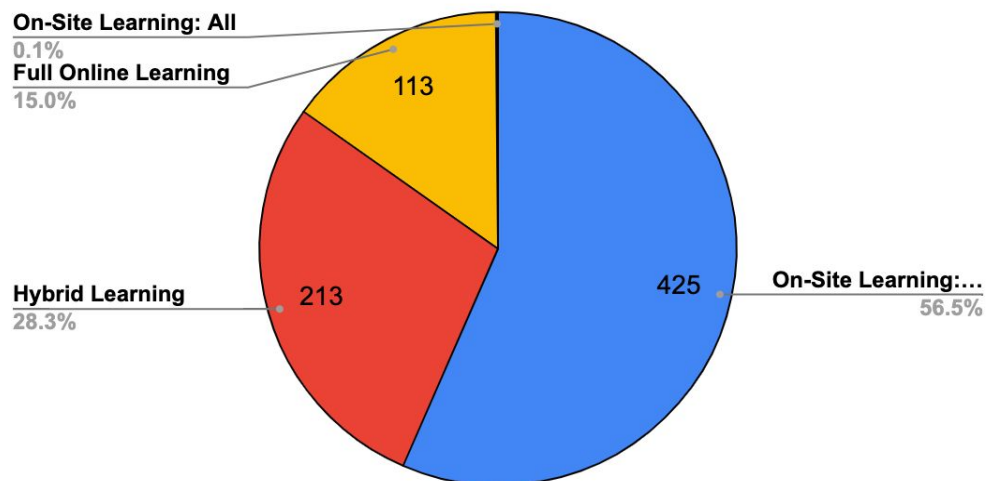

Academic program(s) in which your child(ren) participate



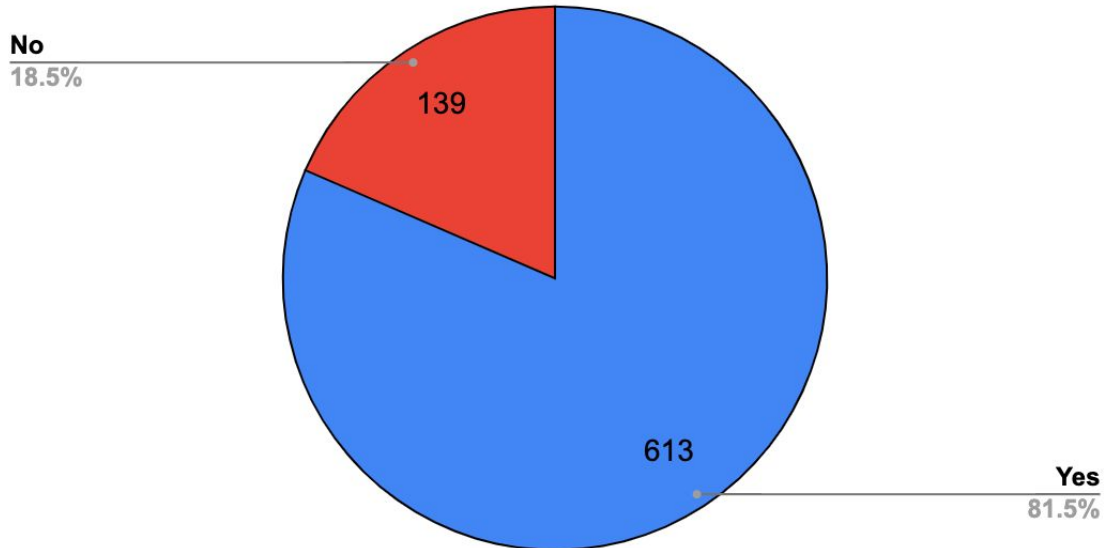
Which Return-to-Learn option would you prefer for the beginning of the 2020-21 school year?

Given the opportunity to return all students to school, on-site, do you intend to send your child(ren) to school?



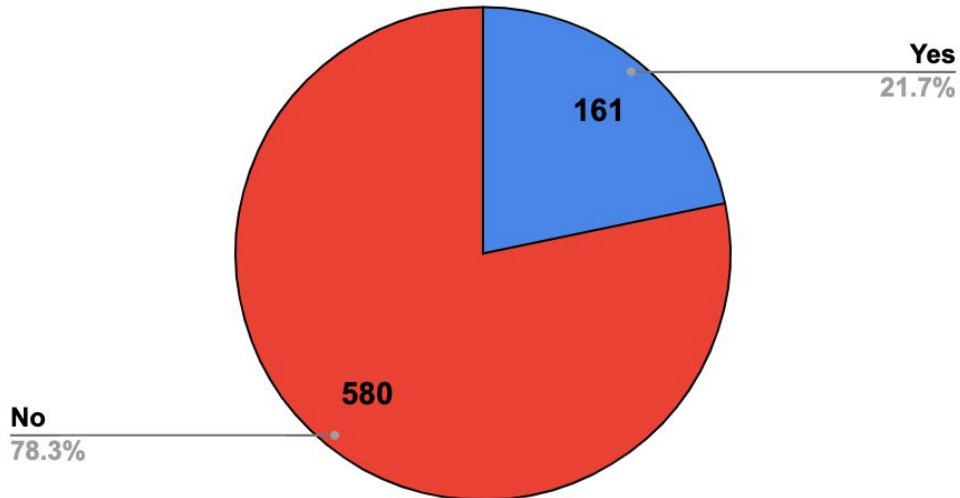
What are your apprehensions for sending your student(s) back to school? (167 Responses)

- Scheduling

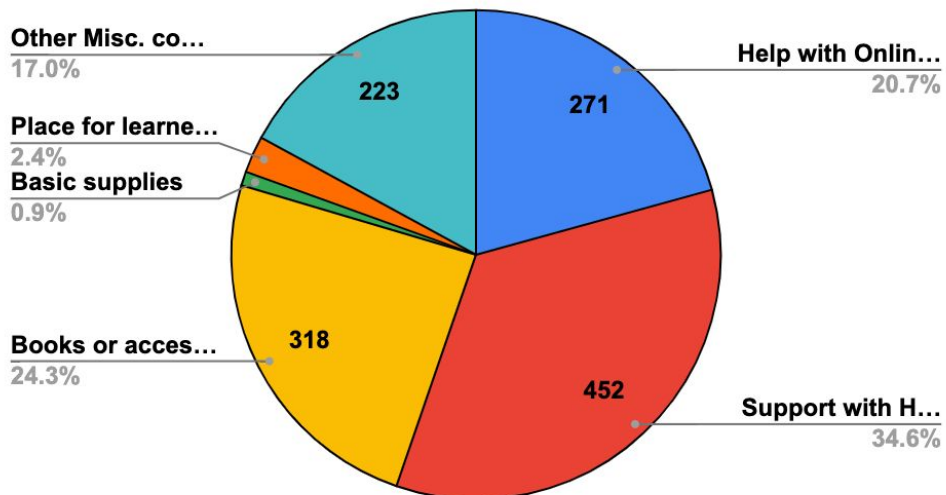

Need Childcare in Hybrid or Online Model



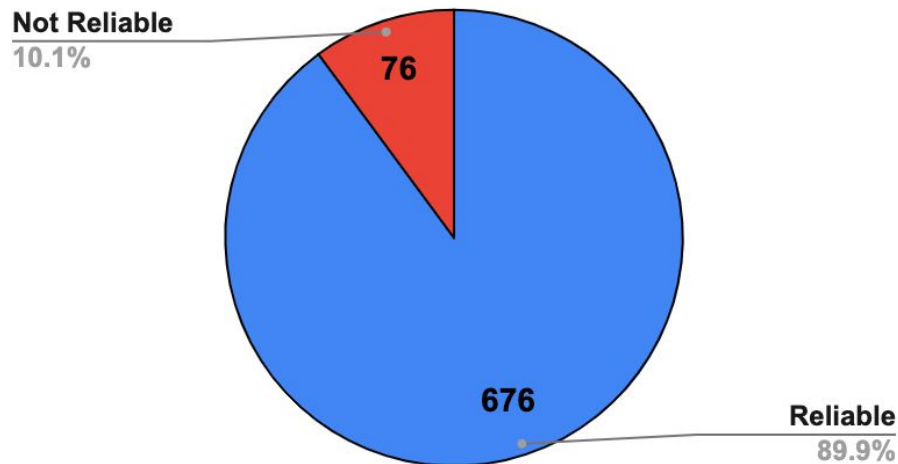
Supports Needed w/ Online Learning

What other barriers would stand in the way of your child engaging in a virtual learning environment? (475 Responses)

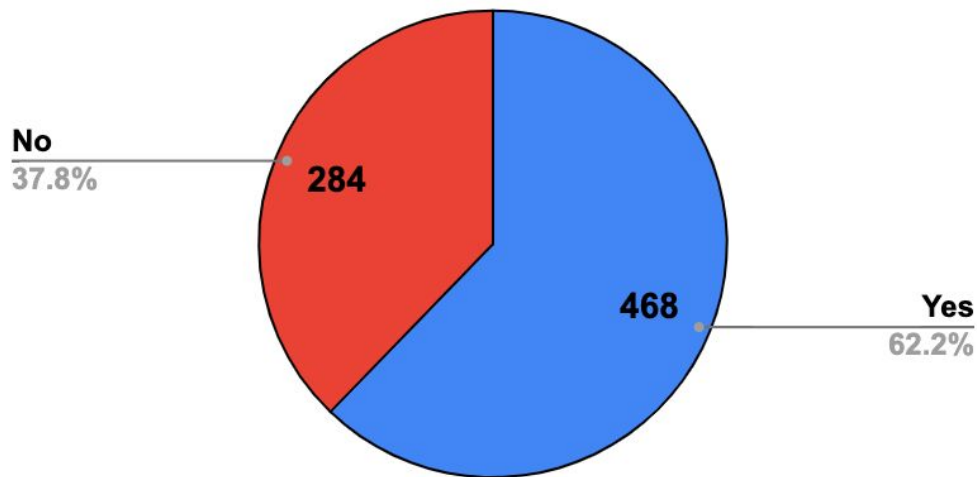
- Parents work schedule/ children home alone, supervision of students learning at home or daycare (n=115)
- Students ability to complete work/accountability/attention span/need from a trained adult support (n=98)
- Need for SEL/social interaction/mental health concerns (n=21)
- Communication/help/support from teachers with online learning platforms assigned work and strict schedules (n=32)
- Lack of technology devices (n=31)
- I am worried about my student falling behind or not being pushed academically. My student has special needs (n=30)
- Need for SEL/social interaction/mental health concerns (n=21)
- Lack of reliable internet (n=15)
- None at this time (n=9)
- Management of multiple students in different grades/on different schedules (n=6)
- Would prefer paper materials/less screen time (n=5)

What other concerns regarding transportation do you have? (240 Responses)

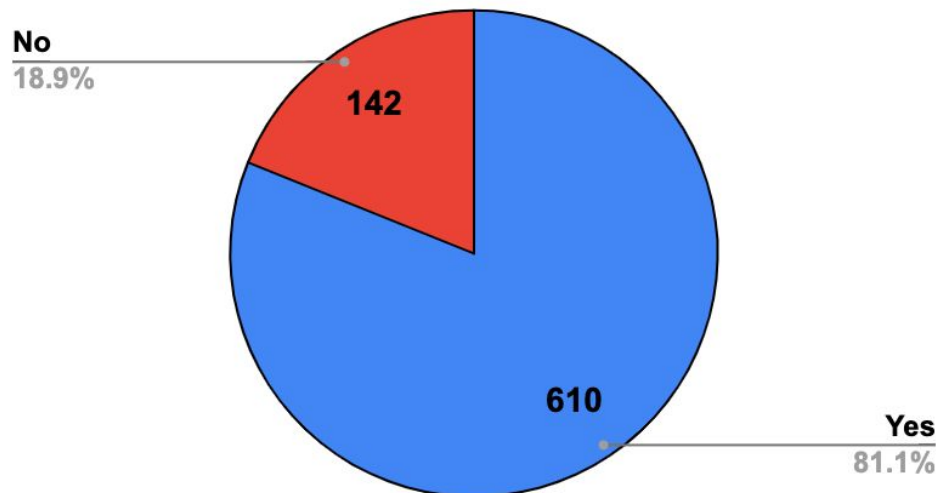
- No concerns (n=108)

If Masks are Required Will You Send Your Child?



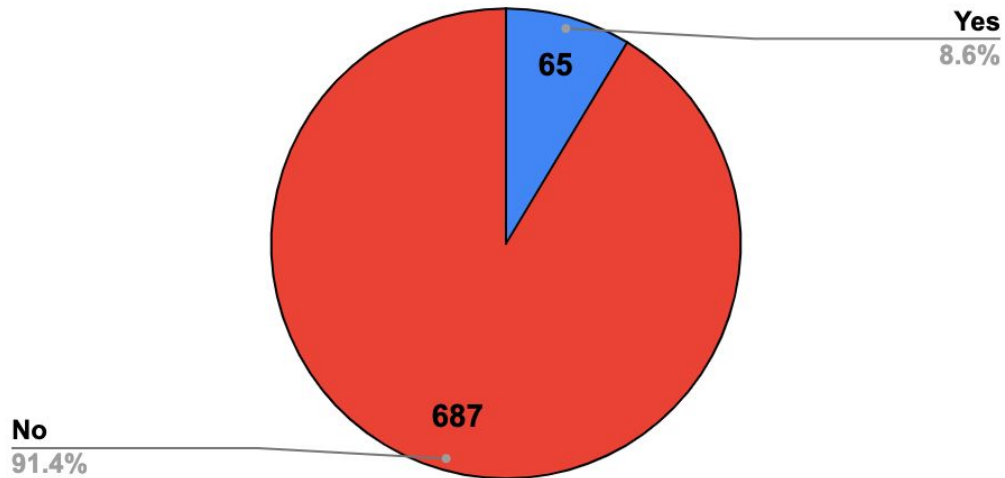
Please explain your reasoning for the previous question and/or any additional concerns with your child(ren) wearing a mask/face covering. (435 responses)

- Students and/or staff should be required to wear masks, we support masks being worn (n=121)
- Students won't keep them on or wear them properly (n=64)
- Don't necessarily agree with masks but will support school/send students if they are required (n=51)
- Health concerns with requiring students to wear masks (n=45)
- Concerns with school/staff's ability to keep masks on students (n=40)
- Don't support masks as they will interfere with teaching and learning (n=25)
- We don't agree with requiring masks, lack of evidence to support them etc. (n=25)
- Allow students to take masks off during certain times of the day and provide parent/student choice. (n=22)
- Will/may not send students if masks are required, if masks are required we shouldn't be going back to school etc. (n=20)
- Will not support school in enforcing their child to wear a mask. (n=15)
- Need to include additional social distancing measures (hybrid -1/2 capacity) (n=13)
- Will send kids no matter what even with some concerns (n=12)
- Will not be sending our students to school masks or not (n=8)
- No concerns (n=8)
- Who will provide masks, how many will they need, who will launder them etc.(n=7)
- Bullying and harassment concerns with students wearing masks (n=3)

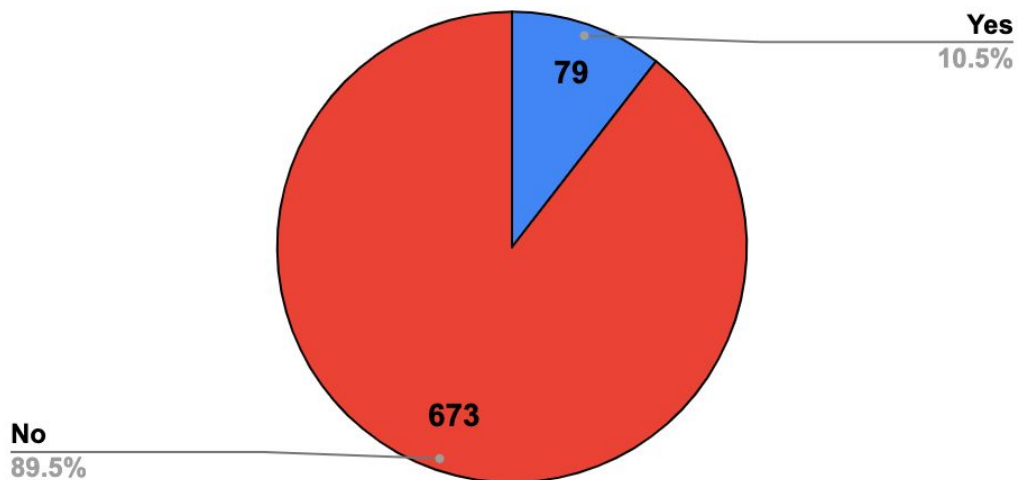

Should the school district be aware of any underlying health conditions or other risk factors impacting your child's ability to attend onsite or hybrid learning this school year?



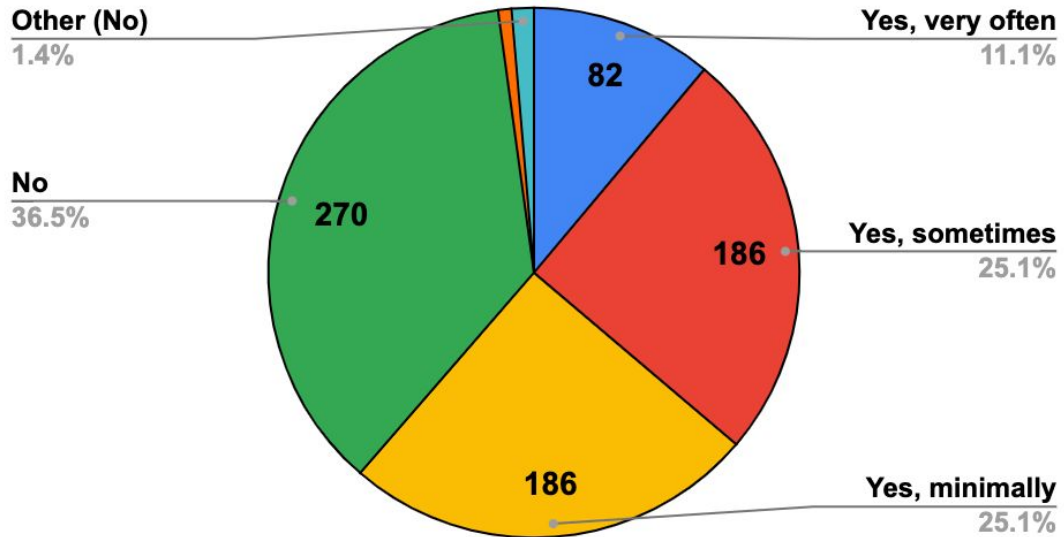
Should the school district be aware of any underlying health conditions or other risk factors in your home impacting your child(ren)'s ability to attend onsite or hybrid learning this school...



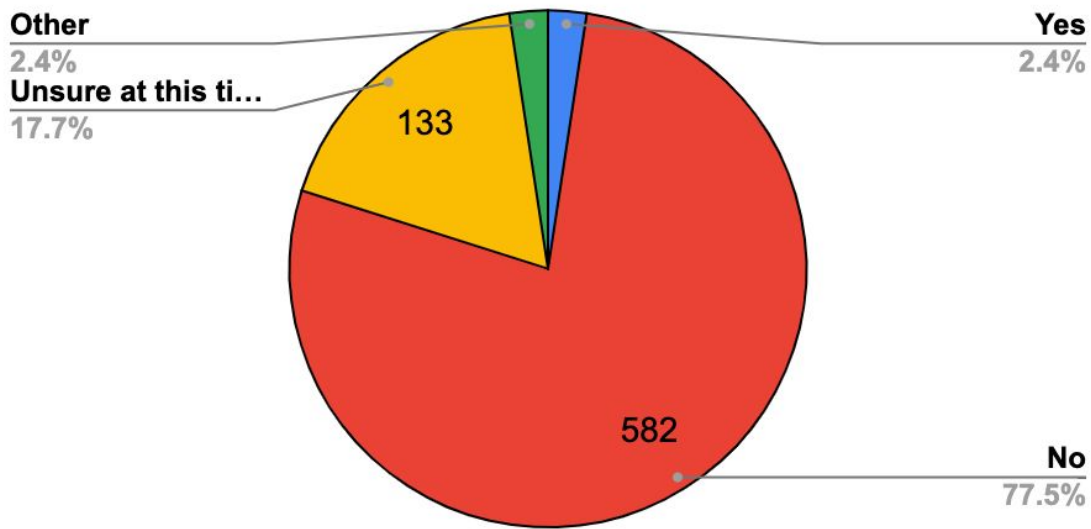
